Attendance Policy 2011-2012

School Starts at 7:45!!!!

Attendance is an important factor in determining your child's academic success.

We encourage you, as stated by the Education Code, to send your child to school on time and on a daily basis. *The California Education Code (CEC), Section 48200, states that it is the RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN, OR ADULT CUSTODIAN,* to ensure their child (ages 6-18) attends school fulltime everyday. In addition, CEC Section 48260 states: "Any pupil subject to compulsory full time education who is absent from school without a valid excuse on three occasions or tardy for more than thirty-minutes in a school day on three occasions in one year is truant and will be reported to the attendance supervisor or the superintendent of the school district."

*Note 95% is required by LAUSD for grades 6-8. No student should exceed a total of 10 days for the school year. Excessive absences will result in a parent conference, meeting with administration, and possibly a district Student Review Board (SARB). All absences must be properly documented by a doctor's note, court notice, or any proof of approved explanation.
